Today N.S.S. Training College, Changanacherry celebrating its 59th annual day. With your permission I am hereby presenting a brief report outline of the activities of the college during the academic year 2012-13.

This college is established in 1954 with the grace of the great visionary sri. Manthu Pathmanabhan. This college is one of the premier teacher education institution in the state of Kerala and has completed 59 years service to the nation in the field of teacher education. At present this institution offers B.Ed course in Mathematics, Physical science, Natural science, Social science, Malayalam, English and Hindi with a strength of 165. The institution is recognized as one of the best college of education in Kerala affiliated under Mahatma Gandhi University

. The admission procedure of B.Ed started in the second week of Nov. and classes were started from Nov. 14 , 2012. This year the course strength was 164, out of them more than 90% are girls.

This year the institution maintained high standard in its academic activities. In this connection, I am happy to state that this college produced excellent result in University examination. Last year, the pass percentage of B.Ed is 100% in the university level. This year also in the 1st semester examination 100% pass. I congratulate the students for their Brilliant performance and teachers who made it possible.

This year the institution has its teaching staff with a strength of 13 teachers and 13 administrative staff. The college is fortunate of having a dedicated & experienced teaching faculty and very good administrative staff. Among staff Smt. Cristal Gladis, Principal retired from service and I joined in the place. Dr. Rema Devi, Associate Professor promoted as Principal and transferred from this college. The tenure of Srividhya Nair, FIP Substitute Lecturer in English ended and Smt. Beena Rani re-joined. In the administrative wing C.S.Venugopalan Nair(UDC) and Radhakrishnan(LGS) were retired from service. Sri V.G. Vijayakumar(HA), N.Radhamani Amma(Typist), K.S. Balagopalan Nair(LGS), and Sreekala S(LGS) transferred to other NSS Colleges. K.R. Balakrishnan Nair(HA), N. Balakrishna Panicker(UDC), B.Jayaprakash(Typist), Shylajakumari and K.R. Shaji(LGS) are newly joint in this college. I warmly welcome all newcomers to this college.

The students in this college were getting a variety of opportunities to participate in curricular and co-curricular activities for the intellectual, emotional, physical and spiritual development of students. For providing basis for healthy competition, a house system was introduced. The whole students were divided into four houses namely, Blue bell, Lavender, Iris, and Daffodils. One hour in every week is dedicated for cultural activities and every morning 9.45 to 10.00 a.m for Thought for the day, Book review and Assembly.
