CONTINUATION ORDER

WHEREAS, recognition u/s 14 (3)(a) of NCTE Act, 1993 was granted to the institution namely N.S.S Training College, Changanacherry, Pessuna Post, Kottayam District, Kerala – 686102 run by Nair Service Society, Head Office, Changanacherry, Kerala – 686102 vide order no. F.KL/Sec/SRO/NCTE/1999-2000/5211 dt. 22.03.2000 for conducting Secondary course of one year.

2. AND WHEREAS, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution has submitted affidavit on 21.01.2015 for its willingness of two units in B.Ed. course and adherence of provisions of new Regulations. Thereafter, a Revised Provisional Recognition Order was issued to the institution on 15.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 150 Students (three basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.

3. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 381st Meeting held on October 31 & November 01, 2019 considered the matter and decided to issue SCN in all such matters where the institution has not submitted the requisite documents/VT Repost accompanied with requisite documents in respond to RPRO issued by the SRC. Accordingly, Show Cause was issued on 21.08.2020. The institution has submitted its reply on 01.10.2020.

4. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 397th Meeting held on 25th & 26th March, 2021 has considered the matter and decided to issue Final Show Cause to the institution. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 06.04.2021. The institution has submitted reply on 07.05.2021, 23.04.2021 & 23.07.2021.

5. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 412th Meeting held on 05th & 06th July, 2022 has considered the matter and decided to issue last reminder (Letter) to the institution. Accordingly, as per decision of SRC last reminder (Letter) was issued to the institution on 21.07.2022. The institution has submitted its reply on 13.09.2022.

6. AND WHEREAS, the SRC has received a mail from the institution on dated 01.12.2022 whereby the institution has requested recognition of B.Ed. for one unit programme

7. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 417th Meeting held on 01st & 02nd December, 2022 has considered the matter and decided as follows: -

8. **NOW THEREFORE**, this order is issued permitting the institution i.e., N.S.S. Training College, Survey No. 163/4, Changanerry, Pessuna Post, Kottayam District, Kerala- 686102 run by Nair Service Society, Survey No. 163/4, Changanerry, Pessuna Post, Kottayam District, Kerala - 686102 for Continuation of recognition for B.Ed. programme for two years duration with an annual intake of 1 basic unit of 50 students subject to fulfilment of the following conditions: -

- I. The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Raising loan against the FDRs or mortgaging them shall not be done.
- II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
- III. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
- IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.

9. Further, the institution is required to fulfil all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University /Body, the State Government etc. as applicable.

10. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee as Self – Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

11. The institution shall maintain its Website with hyperlink to the Council and the Southern Regional Committee, covering, inter – alia, the details of the institution, its locations, name of the programme(s) with intake; available of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms, and other facilities of amenities; instructional facilities, such as laboratory and library and the particulars of their teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website namely: -

- a. Sanctioned programme(s) along with annual intake in the institution:
- b. Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
- c. Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last, quarter:
- d. Name of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.
- e. Fee charged from students.
